The Third Network Seminar**

The United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat) promotes sustainable urban development toward the achievement of SDG Goal 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities. The Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific (ROAP), established in Fukuoka in 1997, leads initiatives in 15 country offices and around 300 staff members working on various projects in partnership with national governments in Asia and the Pacific Region.

As cities in Asia and the Pacific Region face growing challenges such as housing shortages, infrastructure gaps, and climate change, UN-Habitat ROAP established the Tokyo Platform for Sustainable Cities in Asia and the Pacific as a collaborative platform bringing together the private sector, government, academia, and civil society organizations interested in promoting sustainable urban development through a series of seminars held in Tokyo and Fukuoka.

The seminar will feature two panel sessions. The first panel session, "Best Practices and Insights from Japanese Companies' Engagement in UN-Habitat Projects," will highlight experiences shared by companies that have collaborated with UN-Habitat, showcasing approaches to international cooperation using Japanese technologies and expertise.

The second panel session, "Urban Development under Climate Change," will look toward GREEN×EXPO 2027, with experts discussing the use of green infrastructure and nature-based solutions to support future technical collaboration.

In addition, a Co-Creation Network Session in a World Café format will bring together UN-Habitat staff from the Asia-Pacific region and participating organizations to exchange views on current challenges, needs, and future technologies, and to explore new opportunities for public-private collaboration and co-creation.

We look forward to the participation of companies and organizations interested in sustainable urban development in the Asia-Pacific region. Participation in the networking reception only is also welcome.
